Assignment: Multimedia Painting: Rough Draft

Objective:

Students will be able to hypothesize new ways in which art can influence perception and understanding of human experiences in order to plan a surreal Multimedia Painting with both collage and painted components Pixlr, using the Select, Arrange, Picker, and Draw tools on multiple layers.

Essential Questions:

- How do media artists generate ideas?
- How can ideas for media arts productions be formed and developed to be effective and original?
- How do media artists organize and develop ideas and models into process structures to achieve the desired end product?

Assignment Description:

This assignment will provide students the opportunity to build on their digital painting and collage skills in Pixlr. This assignment is designed as a learning opportunity for students to become proficient at using digital tools for artmaking while engaging in surreal thinking.

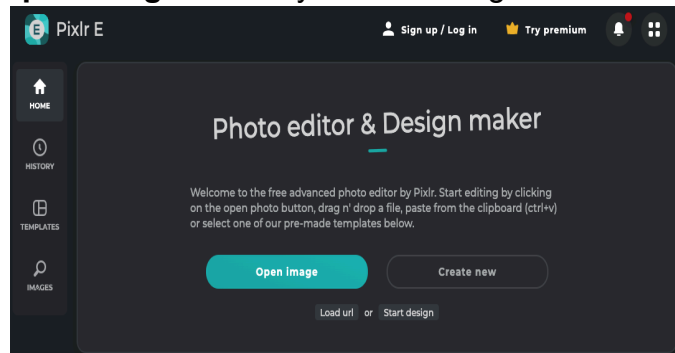

Assignment Directions:

In order to successfully submit this assignment you need to complete the following steps:

Step 1: Open Pixlr - - - > [CLICK HERE](#)

Step 2: Click on **Open Image**. Select your **first** image.

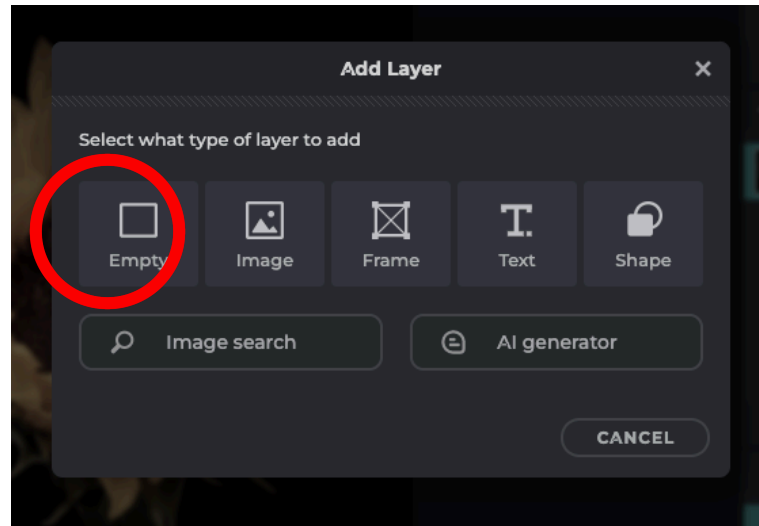


Step 3: In the **Layers Palette**, unlock the background image.

Step 4: Use the **select tool** to cut your reference image. You can make as many cuts as you like, but you have to get to the “center” of your subject. Remember, we want to see what’s inside, so make sure you have some empty space.



Step 5: Then, add your **second picture as a new layer**. You can copy and paste the picture in, or use the new layer button to add an image. Clicking on the “+” sign underneath the layers palette, and select **image**.

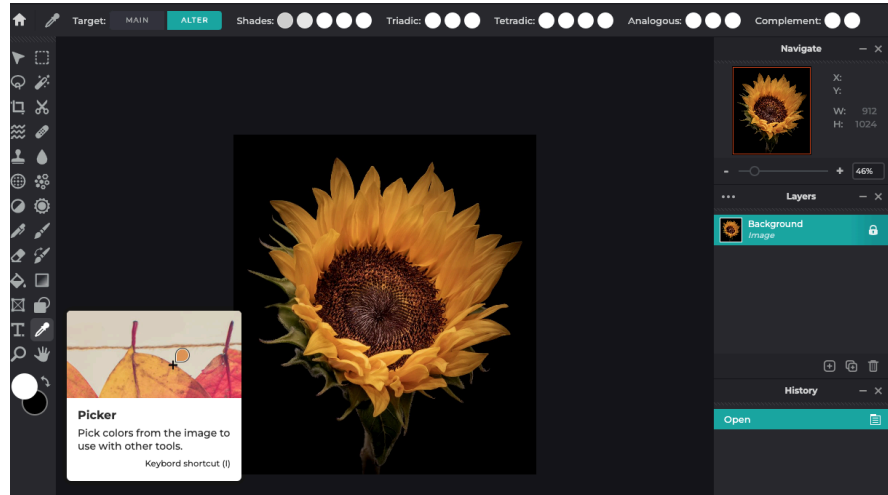


Step 6: Arrange your **second picture** so you can see it beneath or on top of your first image.

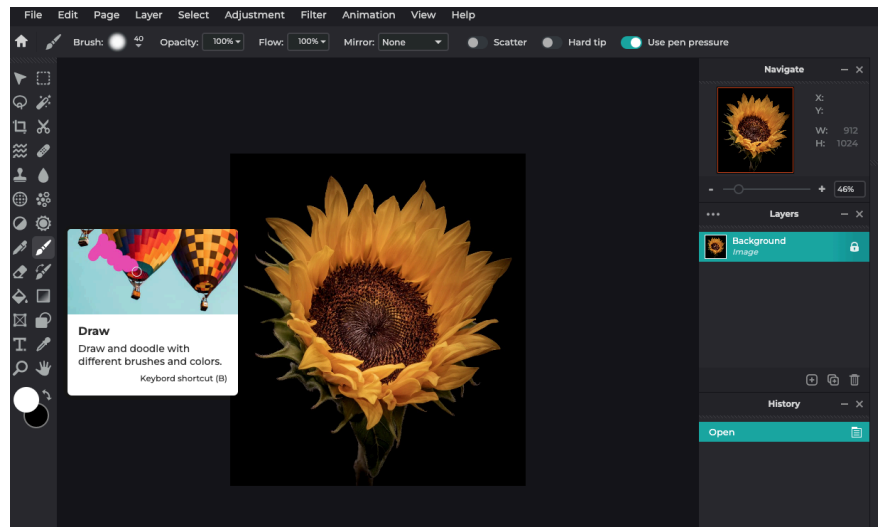


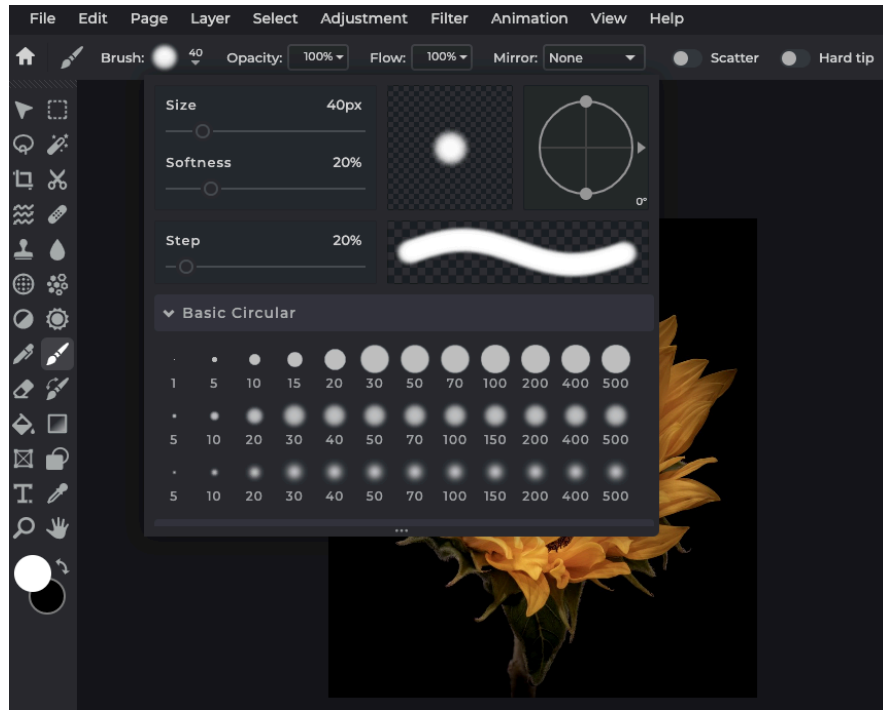
Step 7: Now that you have your collage, you must fill **50%** of your picture with paint. You can choose to paint over your images or add in details.





Once you have your color matched, now you will begin to paint. Click on the **Draw Tool**, in the toolbar. Afterwards, select the type of brush, width and style you would like to use. These changes can all be modified at the top of the screen.





Using the **Draw Tool**, please click on your image and begin to paint.

Repeat the process of color selection and painting.
