Dear Seniors!

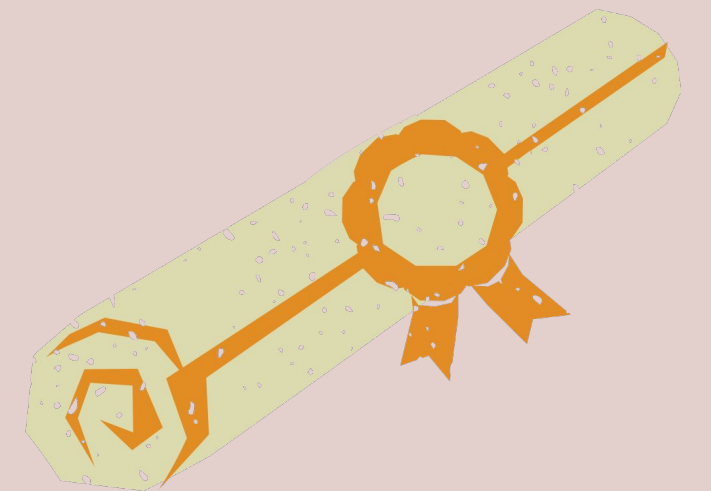
